Top French tourist destination after Paris: 11 million visitors per year. USA is the 4th international market with nearly 400,000 visitors.

Top 5 sites visited by Americans:

Nice Cannes Monaco Antibes Juan-les-Pins St Paul de Vence

Top French international airport after Paris.

The Nice Côte d'Azur Airport offers flights to more than 100 destinations, direct to 33 countries.

The Côte d'Azur and nature

75 miles of coastline, including 25 miles of beaches.

Delightful weather (+300 sunny days a year) with an exceptional climate in winter.

A superb hotel capacity

646 hotels with accommodation capacity of 59,000 beds (of which 46% are rated 4-star and 5-star).
