

BIG MOUNTAIN BATTLE

This exciting, unique event is a kind of orientation race over the Les Gets ski area in which any experienced skier or snow boarder can participate.

The objective of this multi-discipline event is to pass through a series of marked checkpoints as quickly as possible (in under 3 hours). Teams of 2 racers will each be given a route map while organisers follow their progress in real time, via GPS, to ensure all checkpoints have been crossed.

After the Le Mans-style start, each team races to find the various compulsory routes and complete them in the fastest time possible. To win requires strategic, methodical and tactical planning, and a good sense of direction, as each team can choose its own route over the area to cut precious seconds from their overall time, (checkpoints can be crossed in any order the participants choose).

To maximise participation in the race and include skiers of all levels, there are 3 categories: Snowboard Competition, Ski Competition and Ski Discovery (for families). In this way both experienced and less experienced skiers can explore the ski area in a fun and exciting way.

ROCK THE PISTES FESTIVAL FROM 26TH TO 30TH MARCH 2014

This event, marking the start of the music festivals' season, combines snow sports and music. Enjoy free, open-air daytime concerts in a different resort each day and use your ski-pass as your entrance ticket! ON THE SLOPES



On either side of the village are the two slopes of Les Chavannes and Mont Chéry. Each ski area has its own characteristics making them the perfect playground for skiers of all levels.

THE MONT CHERY TRAINING CENTRE

Opposite the Mont Blanc mountain chain, Mont Chéry's slopes are generally the choice of more experienced skiers, freestylers and ski-clubs, who regularly train in the area. There are special prices for ski-clubs, competitions are organised regularly and posts and stopwatches are available for training purposes.

More intimate, it is ideal for the more reflective skier and the perfect environment for powder skiing. The runs are mainly red and black and there are also two slalom runs and a snowpark with an airbag.

SNOWPARK AND FREESTYLE AIRBAG

What could be better than having the facilities to improve your skills located opposite one of the most stunning panoramas in the region? The Mont Chéry snowpark has rails, boxes, kicks and other freestyle modules. At the bottom of the piste is an airbag where skiers can learn freestyle or perfect their technique. This huge inflatable cushion measuring 15m x 11m provides a safe, soft landing. Free of charge.

THE MAUVE MILKA SKI RUN®



DEBORAH ANTHONIOZ BOARDER CROSS

This Boarder Cross run was designed with advice from the local Olympic vice-champion (Vancouver's 2010 winter Olympic games), Deboarah Anthonioz. Originally from Les Gets, Deborah is a valuable ambassador for the resort. This is one of only a very few permanent Boarder Cross installations in France with the capacity for International competitions. It is open to the skiing public throughout the winter and enjoys a continual supply of snow thanks to a row of specially designed snow cannons. THE PERRIERES VIDEOPARK

You can now watch yourself improve over the parallel slalom on skis or snowboard thanks to this exciting area fitted with cameras and stopwatch. The video system starts automatically when you pass your ski pass through the checkpoint at the top of the slalom. When you finish your run, you can watch your personal video on a screen or see it on the website and share it on social networks. It is free of charge and access is via the Perrières Express chairlift from the bottom of the Mélèzes ski run.

Les Gets is part of the Portes du Soleil, one of the biggest ski areas in the world, comprising 12 interconnected resorts in France and Switzerland with 650 km of ski runs. La Grande Ourse

Located in the Mont Chéry area, this mountain restaurant offers a fairytale panorama over the Mont Blanc range and surrounding mountains. This young Japanese cheesemaker will share his know-how with holidaymakers during weekly guided visits.

In the evening, excellent Savoyard specialities are served in the original cheese-maturing cellars transformed into a charming ferme-auberge. Traditional, cosy with a retro feel, there is no warmer atmosphere to be found in Les Gets.



HERITAGE

The Mechanical Music Museum

For both its originality and historical interest, the museum is well worth a visit. Covering 1500m2, it pays homage to man's ingenuity in constructing machines, some dating from the 17th century, designed to reproduce the sound of musical instruments.

Musical boxes, phonographs, Barbary organs, automatic pianos, all in perfect working order are exhibited chronologically throughout the museum's various rooms. Roger & Gallay, the renowned perfumier's collection is on display in one of the rooms.

The star of this magnificent collection is the museum's prize possession, the Aeolian Philharmonic organ, classed as an Historical Monument. An imposing structure that has found a home in Les Gets' church, and works in both manual and automatic modes.

Don't miss the latest exhibit at the museum. The mechanical bells marking the 150th anniversary of the Savoie's annexation to France.

ECO-TOURISM

THE ENVIRONMENT, A MAJOR CONCERN IN THE MOUNTAINS

Les Gets has long been aware of the issues involved in sustainable development, and continues to give priority to initiatives promoting responsible tourism. The resort has instigated many projects designed to preserve its environment. The various schemes are all aimed at raising visitors' awareness and encouraging local inhabitants, both residential and professional, to participate. Some examples:

- Introduction of an environmental charter for hotels and other accommodation providers highlighting the most ecologically responsible.
- The ski area, Tourist Office and Les Gets Golf Club have all obtained the ISO 14001 certification (the golf club is the first club in France to have done so). An independent audit is carried out each year.
- Les Gets resort is also a member of the international organisation Alpine Pearls, represented in 6 Alpine countries (Germany, Austria, France, Italy, Slovenia and Switzerland). The Alpine Pearl organisation consists of 27 tourist destinations that have signed up to a sustainable development initiative aimed at increasing environmental protection in the Alps through tourism and transport.

LES GETS ON ROUTE FOR 2020!

Conscious of its environmental footprint and continually looking to the future, Les Gets is currently working on a new environmental development strategy for 2020.

In 2011, the town participated in the European 'ClimAlp Tour' project (Climate change and its impact on tourism in the Alps). Its principal objectives were:

- To analyse the possible impact of climate change on tourist sites in the Alps
- To analyse the strengths and weaknesses, assets, limitations and

vulnerability of resorts to climate change

- To propose management and adaption strategies to improve sustainable tourism in Les Gets.

In an extension of this project the town is drawing up its 'Strategy 2020' development paper, outlining plans to implement the 'ClimAlp Tour' findings into practical, concrete actions that will

ECO-ACTIONS IN LES GETS

Here are a few examples of initiatives introduced over the years in both the village and ski areas:

- Wood-fired central-heating. Since 2000, a wood-fired heating system using re-claimed wood has heated 12 municipal buildings via a heating network over a kilometer long.
- Provision of pocket ashtrays at all lift kiosks
- Introduction of an environmental charter for accommodation providers highlighting the most ecologically responsible. A hotel charter is currently being drawn up.
- Local services and businesses involved in preserving the environment (geothermal systems, heat pumps, organic wines, local produce, organic products used for ski maintenance).
- ISO 14001 certification of the 18-hole golf club (first in France to obtain this certification) and the Tourist Office.
- Lift-pass recycling. All passes of three days or more are sold in a rechargeable hands-free format, so can be reused. The disposable 1-3 day lift-pass will be replaced by a flexible handsfree card that clients can put in special collection bins after use. They will then be recycled to provide on new lift passes.
- Speed regularisation of certain lifts. To avoid frequent stops, certain lifts now move very slowly, to reduce energy consumption.
- The Chery Nord radio repeater operates using solar panels.
- Excavation works over the summer months to create gentler slopes and so preserve the snow. The objective is to reduce the piste-bashers' work and limit snow canon use.
- Re-turfing of the summer activity area. This protects the ground from erosion, integrates the pistes with the natural countryside, helps stabilise the snow cover and encourages biodiversity.
- A protection zone for Black Grouse has been established with signposting explaining the protected species.
- Eco –Friendly Transport. Semi-pedestrianised area, closure of the rue du centre on certain days, resort mini bus service, Balad'Aulps Bus' Line serving the valley, little trains to get around in winter and visit the tourist attractions in summer. Evening mini-bus service direct to your accommodation from 6.30pm to 11.00pm, every day during the season for only 2€/ person (free for children -12 yrs accompanied by an adult).
- Biodegradable oil for piste bashers
- An annual rubbish-collection day over the ski area



- Rigorous water controls, reservoirs for drinking water, new generation snow canons (more energy efficient), additive-free snow manufacture.
- Participation in European and environmental initiatives in conjunction with partners such as l'Ademe, Priorieterre, Mountain Riders, Alpine Pearls, Clim'Alp Tour, The University of Savoie Mont Blanc ...
- Creation of eco-events during which environmental considerations are taken into account in various areas: location of the reception area, catering and food provision by local suppliers, use of recycled paper or PEFC. In addition, there will be shows and events on environmental themes as was demonstrated during French Mountain Bike Championships 2012 and by the themed weeks during summers (The Four Elements, The Environment)....
- Public awareness of the eco-actions (accommodation, events, ...).
- Purchase of guaranteed 'eco-cups' for events.
- Environmentally-friendly purchasing policy at SaGets, the Golf Club and the Tourist Office.
- A 'Spectacular nature' vegetable garden created in the summer.
- Presence detectors to economise on light and heating in new premises and in detachable lift stations.
- New garage construction conforming to all current environmental regulations.
- Inventories and preservation action plans for the natural wet lands in the ski area.
- Lift cabins washed with a biodegradable product.
- Developing and increasing use of new technology for communication (web, e-mail, smartphone).

benefit future development in Les Gets. The findings will be considered in conjunction with the Institut de la Montagne and plans on how to manage territorial and tourism development from now until 2020 will be developed. The aim is to continue the resort's policy of sustainable development (environmental, economic and social) and to position Les Gets as an 'Eco-village'.

In order to do this, 4 areas will be studied each with its own working party:

- **Planning:** Manage construction and preserve open spaces. Facilitate new year-round inhabitants.
- **Transport:** Totally pedestrianise the village centre (no cars).

- **Economy:** Provide balanced economic development between activities and seasons.
- **Ecology:** Preserve and develop the local (resources and quality of life) and global environment. Anticipate and adapt to climate change.

The objective for the end of 2013 is to present short, medium and long term proposals for the future development of the village.




