A LITTLE BIT OF HISTORY...



Morzine has many positive characteristics: the village is very well located, near Geneva and a major spa town, Evian. Its average altitude is suitable for all ages, its climate is refreshing and healthy. Its surroundings are nice and people are hospitable.

It was after the World War that the tourism era really started. In 1935, a bus line was set between Morzine and Cluses, ensuring correspondence with the «Snow Train» line between Paris and Saint-Gervais. Ski resorts started getting really popular. In 1936, Morzine already had 15 hotels, 5 pensions, 60 rental chalets but also one hotel and one chalet situated in the mountain. All in all, it represented 850 beds for holiday rent, accommodation for 2,500 people in summer and 1800 in winter. Morzine then became the best equipped resort in the Chablais region to host tourists. At the same time, 5 Ski Schools opened. The first one was created in 1936 by the «Paris Alpine Ski Club». The fifth one was founded on February 27, 1939 by a group of instructors and was given the name of «Ecole de ski Morzine». In 1942, the five schools gathered and took the name of «Ecole du Ski Français».


In the 1930's, Morzine become «the» place to be for winter sports and through the years, it could adapt to the demands of tourism while preserving its authentic charm, its cultural and architectural heritage. Today, Morzine stands out with its connection to 650 km of runs in the Portes du Soleil ski area. Its central position in the ski area, its location at the bottom of the ski runs and its easy access (highway is only 35 km away and Geneva International Airport is only 75 minutes away) makes Morzine a popular destination for French and foreign skiers.

New disengageable Pléney Gondola



The era of cable cars arrived in the 1930s and it was in 1934 that the Pléney gondola was inaugurated in the presence of the Minister of Labour. It is a total of 511m of elevation up to 1446m at the top. The flow from the skiers was too much and the gondola could not cope. Therefore, it was supported by a second cable car in 1964 made by the manufacturer SACMI. This lift was the leader of automatic four-seater gondolas developed by Poma manufacturer from 1967. Poma was also in charge of it replacement in 1980 by the current six seaters gondola. Today, the requirements of customers involved the modernization of facilities and Poma is back at work in Morzine for 2013.

New disengageable Pléney Gondola



At the end of the last winter season, the Pléney lift company started to work to ensure the replacement of the Pléney gondola for winter 2013/2014.

The previous structure did not fulfill anymore the needs of skiers in terms of comfort and speed.

Therefore, the new lift will consist of **54 ten-seater gondolas** that will be in service at the beginning of the season 2013/2014 on an 11 pylon route.

Its route has not changed and the lift will carry **3,000 people per hour** against 1700 for the previous lift. But the project does not only stop at lifts. It also includes the demolition and reconstruction of the building containing the cash desks and the office of the Pleney lift company, so all its departure area is redesigned for greater comfort for skiers through the whole process from purchasing the skipass to getting into the new lift.

In addition, the arrival station at the top will have better accessibility for skiers and pedestrians.

The new building will have a snowy winter cover that can be used to walk with a view on the village or the slopes. The curved and translucent facades of the station will be trimmed with wood siding with vertical «skylight» to allow more light.

In addition, the layout of the arrival station will facilitate accessibility for skiers, pedestrians and disabled.

New «3S» Prodains lift



The Prodains cable car, providing access to the Avoriaz ski resort from Morzine was replaced by a new 3S unit. This type of lift is the most

advanced technology currently available in the cable car industry and can be characterized as a «detachable cable». Its main advantages are exceptional comfort, a high-speed line (7 meters / second) and therefore a high flow.... (2,000 to 2,400 persons / hour depending on the number of cars). Only six of these cable cars are currently in service in the world. Technically, there are two carrier cables and 1 tractor cable for 580 meters of elevation.

The departure and arrival stations are new semi-submerged buildings for a better integration in the landscape.

Ideally located, these new ski lifts will develop Morzine as the center and lead player of the Portes du Soleil ski area. Morzine is accessible to a wonderful 650 km of runs playground, one of the most varied in the world, a true invitation to travel, change of scenery from summit to summit, from valley to valley ... with its vast nature to feel free... Besides Morzine has a naturally privileged location for snow falls. The lift companies are also investing to maintain the best conditions for the enjoyment of skiing.

The resort has 30 new snow cannons, which makes 325 facilities on the ski area ensuring a pre-season undercoat and keeping the snow on the main runs.

Last season, the snowfall broke records with 7 meters of accumulated snow on the top of Pléney, 9 meters at 1600m and 15 meters at 2000m high.



Also ...

Chamossière ski area: The exclusive pleasure of skiing

Chamossière could win all the superlatives: the highest point of the Morzine ski area (2002 meters), the longest ski run of the area with 1.751m, chairlifts with a 105 angle at the start ... but this unique area offers above all a wild preserved side with an isolated chairlift taking skiers to two «virgin» valleys. Only two runs, a black and a red, winding on both sides of the mountain.

Then there is the panorama on the magnificent Mont Blanc and a 360° angle view on the Alps! And more importantly, there is the the red «Arbis» run taking you to a preserved and hilly environment with many variations on the slope and a final forest and **freeride safe area** for thrill seekers in the valley of Angolon.

The village is awarded by a «Famille Plus» label for its effort to make things easier for families and children by offering them many age-appropriate infrastructures like snow garden, children ski runs, «Penguins» called children's boarder, sledging, ice skating, Aquatic Center, shows for children, free entertainment, family rates and tailored services...

In Morzine, children are kings. They can switch between fun and varied activities and it is probably why 70% of our customers come on a family holiday and why the resort was given this «Famille Plus» award!



Every week, various shows and activities!

A wide range of free entertainment is offered every week: welcome drinks, ski retrospective and torchlight ski parade, carpentry workshop and wooden games, storytelling, treasure hunt, musical quiz, visit of the barn, visit of the cheese factory...

During the winter school holidays, even more events are organized:

- Free workshops and marching shows in the streets of the village
- Free shows for everybody
- From time to time, on the ski slopes, Speed skiing for beginners and snow music tour (a DJ bonfire on the ski slopes and gives away gifts)



«Babysnow», the ski runs are also for toddlers



The joy of skiing for children under 3 years is possible with the «Babysnow»! This original device is like no other: some relate it to a snow scooter, others find it similar to snowboarding... one thing is certain: it is the **first ski service available from the age of 1 year old** (as long as the child can stand on his/her own).

The «Babysnow» consists of a surfboard, a fixed handle on the front, a saddle and a canvas shaft driven by an instructor. **The child is held on the «Babysnow» by the feet and crotch and he/she is protected by a helmet.** This original activity enables children to be with their parents on the ski area. It is available in Morzine with the ESF.



Riglet, snowboarding for children from 4 to 8 years old

Young aspiring snowboarders will have the opportunity to learn the basics of snowboarding and have fun with equipment adapted to their morphology. Mint snowboard school and Rude Chalets, established in Morzine for many years, have been working with the Burton brand on the «Kids on Snow/Riglet» program to offer unique tailored courses to young kids who may have thought they were too young to practice this discipline. A special batch of Burton equipment called «Learn to Ride» with boards from 80cm are available for children under 8 years old!

Le Chemin des Zouzous (kids slope)

This new ski run, created on the Pléney ski area, opens up the animal world for young skiers. This educational run is 2 km long and decorated with life-size replicas of wild animals.

An original way to discover the local wildlife! Fox, deer, wolf, and other animals of the forest are shown with signs specifying their species. Access to the ski run is open to all skiers. The area is located in the woods, away from the flow of skiers, for greater security.

Finally, small slopes and bumps have been shaped to add a dose of fun to pleasure of learning.

The Nyon Snowpark

The snowpark has been specially designed for children and beginners. The size of its modules are reduced and it offers a variety of elements: varied jumps, tight corners, tunnels....

The Penguins Boarder

A new space was built on the ski area under the theme of penguins that are the emblems of sport in Morzine. In the middle of an icefloe theme, you come across small banked turns, slaloms, tunnels, sharp-shaped turns...





The Aquatic Center in the «Dérêches park»

This indoor aquatic center is located in the heart of the village. To the delight of the whole family, several options are available: sport and fun activities or just a relaxing break. For holiday makers, this offers extra activities out of skiing:

- A sports pool of 25 x 15 meters
- A training pool of 125 m²
- A paddling pool of 50 m²
- A 160 m² spa area with 3 saunas and 2 steam rooms

Various services are available in the Aquatic Center: swimming school, activities (water games, costumes, makeup for Carnival...), ice-skating and snacks for children during the school holidays...

Open from midday to 8pm on weekdays and from 2pm to 8pm on weekends from December 14th to to April 21st 2014 (reopening in June)

The «Piou Piou» club

Just a few steps from the Mas Verjus ski lift, the «Piou-Piou» club has a privileged location in the center of town. It hosts children from 3 to 14 years to teach them how to ski. The courses are taught by instructors of the ESF in a totally secure area. An animation team offers, in addition, a wide range of indoor and outdoor activities.

HOTELS UPGRADE

Morzine is the ski resort in the Alps, which offers the largest amount of hotels (47). Appreciated by customers for its value for money and high level equipment, Morzine has seen four of its hotels reaching the 4-star category between 2012 and 2013, for a result of seven hotels in that range. These hotels are well rewarded for their efforts in planning, services and quality of reception.

- Champs Fleuris Hotel ****: recently acquired a fourth star.



Charming hotel, located at the bottom of the slopes, this is the traditional home of a local family, combining comfort and modernity. From the hotel, you can quickly access a wide range of sports, cultural or relaxing activities and you can enjoy any time the entertainment provided by the shops and the town life.

With 48 rooms and two chalets (chalet Martine and chalet Reine des Prés), decoration was designed with prestigious materials such as wood and Savoyard inspired fabrics.

For winter 2013/2014, the hotel gets a 175m² spa with pool, sauna, steam room and two massage rooms.

You can enjoy the swimming pool, a sensory shower and an ice fountain. This SPA provides specific mountain herbal care and natural products under the brand **SPAS PURE ALTITUDE.**

Renovation also of the fitness center, extension of the garage connected to the hotel, creation of a second lift from the garage to reach all levels and provide easier access for disabled persons. Renovation of the ski room, extension of the living room with creation of a new conference room of 80m².

- La Bergerie Hotel ****:

2 master suites combine local slate material from the mountain. Note: The kitchenettes in the parents' suite are convenient for family meals / a host table exclusively for children in the evening which gives parents freedom to go and have dinner together in the village / a buffet of homemade snacks for very hungry kids after skiing.

- Le Dahu Hotel ****:

A stove area and fireplace for an intimate and cosy atmosphere with stunning views over Morzine. Note: a child care service 6 days out of 7 with dedicated activities / Dinner for children with evening care to give a little bit of free time for parents / A chauffeur service 6 days out of 7 / guiding on the ski slopes in winter 6 days out of 7.

Take a tour of the Portes du Soleil and never take the same ski run twice. This is exceptional skiing!

You can also put on your skins to try ski touring. The ski area is particularly famous for off-piste skiing, with routes for advanced skiers and technically easy routes for beginners so that everybody discovers that other sort of skiing, combining sport and nature discovery.

New: eagles, men and skiing!

Jacques Olivier Travers is a falconer. His passion for mountain and birds made him dream to fly eagles in ski resorts and especially on the snowy slopes of Morzine.

This unique educational experience is to catch the public's attention to the beauty of these birds. They live in their natural environment, in synchronicity with nature and men. This is an original opportunity for everyone that stands at Pointe de Nyon restaurant or on the ski slopes of Morzine.

A symbolic opportunity to find out about the needs to share the natural environment with wildlife.

- With children, take a lunch break at the Pointe de Nyon restaurant. An old huge wooden chalet, a large terrace and a demo flight by the White-tailed eagles. This activity is also open to children from 8 years. Note: 8 to 11 years old children are sitting in the parents sledge.



A new generation of «Paret», light and easy to use

For the record ... Originally, «paret» was the favorite way for children to go to school. The device has been improved to adapt to the slopes and back in force in Morzine for other reasons: slopes and fun!

Discover this new activity with surprising sensations. Modern, light, flexible and comfortable, this is definitely a new way to slide.

On a fully dedicated slope for this practice, whatever your level is, come and challenge yourself on the slope by performing all types of curves in the snow...

The service includes:

- The equipment: yooner + headlamp
- Ski lift pass
- Supervision by professionals

This activity can also be done during the day on two dedicated runs, one blue and one red run, under the guidance of a professional.


An evening in an Alpine chalet
